

### **Peddlers, Itinerant Vendors, Solicitors, Transient Merchants or Vendors Permit Application**

It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, offer for sale, exhibit for sale or for the purpose of taking orders for the sale of any goods or merchandise in the city without first obtaining a permit.

- (1) Complete the upper portion of this form at least ten (10) days prior to contemplated sale / exhibit.
- (2) Pay the sum of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) for annual registration fee.
- (3) Execute a Bond in the sum of not less than two thousand dollars (\$2,000) with two or more good and sufficient sureties, which bond shall be payable to the City of Brownwood for a period of two years.
- (4) Furnish a certified copy of Corporation Charter and Certified Copy of permit to do business in Texas (if incorporated under the laws of another state).
- (5) Furnish copy of sales tax certificate from state comptroller.
- (6) Furnish a letter of authorization from property owner for the sale of items from a property.

It shall be unlawful for any person to peddle, solicit or sell from the streets of the city.

Permits shall not be transferable nor give authority to more than one person to sell or exhibit goods or merchandise other than by his own proper person, but may have assistance from one or more persons who shall aid, but not act for or without the permittee. The permit shall be prominently displayed during the sale and shall not continue for more than forty (40) days from the date of issuance.

In connection with my application for permit/license, the City may conduct an investigation of me as part of the process of considering my candidacy as a peddler, itinerant vendor, solicitor, transient merchant or vendor. I understand that the investigative report may include criminal history. I understand any such information provided shall become the exclusive property of the City of Brownwood.
