CANVASSING VOTES FOR THE 2022 GENERAL ELECTION:

Reading tabulated results of the May 7, 2022, General Election

Larry Franks, Elections Administrator with the Brown County Elections Office read the official tabulated results for Mayor. Stephen E. Haynes received 130 Absentee Votes, 411 Early Votes, and 201 Election Day, for a total of 742. Patrick McLaughlin IV received 18 Absentee Votes, 139 Early Votes, and 114 Election Day, for a total of 271. Councilmembers for Wards 1 and 4 were unopposed.

Consider an ordinance on first/final reading canvassing votes for the May 7, 2022, General Election, and declaring the results.

Mayor Haynes asked the City Secretary to read the ordinance. After the reading of the ordinance, a motion was made by McMillian, seconded by Nowowiejski, to approve the ordinance on first/final reading canvassing the election results. Upon vote, motion carried unanimously.

Oath of Office




ADJOURNMENT:
